

Guided Teaching (ELECT / 1 cr.)

Course Overview

This is an independent study course. It is distinct from other one-credit electives and requires special permission before registering for it. The course is designed to support students who, through their coursework or other related professional activities, have identified a topic or issue in TESOL that they would like to explore further under the guidance of a faculty member. Possible topics of focus include classroom management issues, task design and implementation, textbook adaptation, and classroom assessment. The method of course assessment will vary, but the course will culminate in a significant outcome, such as a paper or presentation. Prior to registering for this course, students should first consult with a faculty member about the possibility of undertaking guided teaching. A study proposal should typically be submitted at least one month prior to the registration period of the semester that the student wishes to take the course.
